## Excursion to Lago di Caldonazzo

Planned for Thursday, October 16, 2025

Lago di Caldonazzo is the largest lake entirely within the Province of Trento—covering roughly 5.4 km² and sitting at about 449 m above sea level. We are planning a **light afternoon hiking trip** in the lake area.

Participants joining the excursion would skip the regular lunch at ECT\* in favor of receiving a take-away lunch package.

## Getting there

The trip with public transportation (**included in Trentino Guest Card, no need to buy tickets**) takes about 1 hour from ECT\*.


- Bus Line 6: ECT\* (Villazzano "Villa Tambosi") → Trento Train Station (Piazza Dante "Stazione Fs")
- 2. Bus B401: Trento, Autostazione → Valcanover

We plan to catch the bus from Trento at 12:36. The connection is available roughly every 30 minutes, so we also have the flexibility to catch a later one.

## Hiking route

For the hike, there are **two different options**, one slightly longer than the other:

- A) Valcanover → Santa Caterina → Prai → Calceranica al Lago (~2h)
- B) Valcanover → Santa Caterina → Prai → Bosentino (~1.5h)



Since only the last part is different for the two routes, we can decide as we go which one to pick.

## Getting back

The trip back to Trento by bus takes between about 40 to 45 minutes. Based on the hiking route, we would take one of two buses:

- A) Bus B450: Calceranica al Lago → Trento (~45 min)
- B) Bus B303: Bosentino → Trento (~40 min)

From Calceranica, we would target to catch the bus at 15:56, with alternatives roughly every hour. Similarly, from Bosentino we would plan to catch the bus at 16:04, also with alternatives roughly every hour.
